A. General Criteria

1. The main author must be registered in the Conference by **February 1, 2017**.
2. **The number of authors should be limited to 10 per paper**, including the main author or presenter (must be underlined).
3. An e-mail address is compulsory in order to receive information about the abstract sent on-line.
4. Only those papers not presented in other conferences or journals will be accepted.
5. The author/s will indicate the format in which he/she/they would like to present the paper (oral or poster). However, the Scientific Committee will decide the final format of the paper presentation (oral or poster).
6. The paper submission will be done under the complete acceptance of all these criteria. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject any paper, if it is not adapted to any of these criteria.
7. The author(s) will be notified on paper acceptance or rejection by e-mail by June 1, 2017. Presentation criteria and other details will also be sent in that notification.
8. **Maximum one paper per (co)author.**

B. Thematic Areas

1. Papers will be gathered in **thematic areas** for assessment and scheduling.
2. Authors must state the **THEMATIC AREA** in which they would like to present their paper at the time of submission.
3. The Programme Committee will always try to respect the author's choice of thematic area. However, this is subject to changes in order to achieve a balanced scientific programme.

The thematic areas are:

1. Criminalistic and Criminal Justice Aspects in Solving and Proving of Criminal Offences
2. Police Organization – Structure and Functioning
3. Contemporary Security Studies
4. Strengthening the State's Institutions and Fight Against Crime
5. Social, Economic and Political Flows of Crime – Manifestation, Measuring and Analysis
6. Forensic Linguistics and Language for Specific Purposes
7. Cybercrime
8. Innovative Techniques and Equipment in Forensic Engineering
9. Effects of Physical Activity on Anthropological Status in Security Agencies Personnel

C. Abstracts Format

All abstracts must contain:

1. **Title:** 15 words maximum, in sentence case and bold letters.
2. **Authors' names:** main author/presenter must be underlined.
3. **Affiliations** of the authors must be included.
4. **Keywords:** 6 keywords maximum.
5. The abstract must not contain more than 300 words.
6. **Font type:** Times New Roman, **font size:** 11 pt.

D. Abstract Submission and Registration

All abstracts should be submitted according to the above-mentioned criteria to the following e-mail address: arcibald17@kpa.edu.rs.

Once you have sent your abstract with keywords, check that you have received a confirmation e-mail. If you do not receive any confirmation or if you have any other problem with the submission procedure, please contact the Organizing Committee (phone No.: +381 11 3107 225).

Upon abstract acceptance, you will be asked to submit the full paper. Papers must be written in accordance with the Instructions for Authors (see Call for Papers). Call for Papers and Paper and Poster templates are available on the website: www.nsar.org.rs.

E. Paper Presentation

Oral Presentations:

- Oral presentations will be limited to 10 minutes each.

Poster Presentations:

- Day dedicated to Poster Exhibition will be determined afterwards. The use of the official poster template is suggested (template is available on the website: www.nsar.org.rs).

Please do not alter the dimensions of the template. Dimensions of the portrait layout poster should be 90 × 70 cm. These specifications should be followed carefully, as with those not adjusted authors risk not to have sufficient space for their presentation.
